jQuery is a fast, small, and feature-rich JavaScript library. It makes things like HTML document traversal and manipulation, event handling, animation, and Ajax much simpler with an easy-to-use API that works across a multitude of browsers. With a combination of versatility and extensibility, jQuery has changed the way that millions of people write JavaScript.

Importing JQuery

For development

```
<script src="https://ajax.googleapis.com/ajax/libs/jquery/3.6.3/jquery.min.js"></script>
```

For production

Always download the JQuery file and import it to your webserver



JQuery Syntax

```
$(Identifier).action(function() {
```

 Whatever you want this function to do

```
});
```

Identifier - The ID or Class or Type of the object you want to interact with

Action - What will trigger or action this function to occur

Example:

```
$('#p').click(function(){
```

```
    $('#p').hide();
```

```
});
```



JQuery Events

There are MANY events (or actions) in JQuery that you can use. Here are a few

- click
- dblclick
- mouseenter
- mouseleave
- keypress
- ready



Lets try it

```
$('#IdOfElement').action(function() {  
});
```

- click
- dblclick
- mouseenter
- mouseleave
- keypress
- change
- load



JQuery Effects

There are multiple animation effects built into JQuery. Here are a few

- Hide
- Show
- Slide
- Animate



JQuery Hide/Show

Hide and Show allow you to hide and show an element on a page. It accepts a speed parameter as well.

```
$("#p").hide();
```

```
$("#p").hide(1000);
```

```
$("#p").show();
```

```
$("#p").show(1000);
```




JQuery Slide

Slide will move an element across the screen in a given direction. It accepts a speed and callback (what will be executed after the slide transition occurs).

```
$("#p").slideUp("slow");
```

```
$("#p").slideDown("slow");
```

```
$("#p").slideToggle("slow");
```



jQuery Animate

Animate allows you to change the CSS properties of any given element. It accepts parameters along with a speed and callback

```
$ ("p").animate ({left: '100px'});
```



jQuery UI

jQuery UI is a library of pre styled elements
